**ITALIAN REPORT**

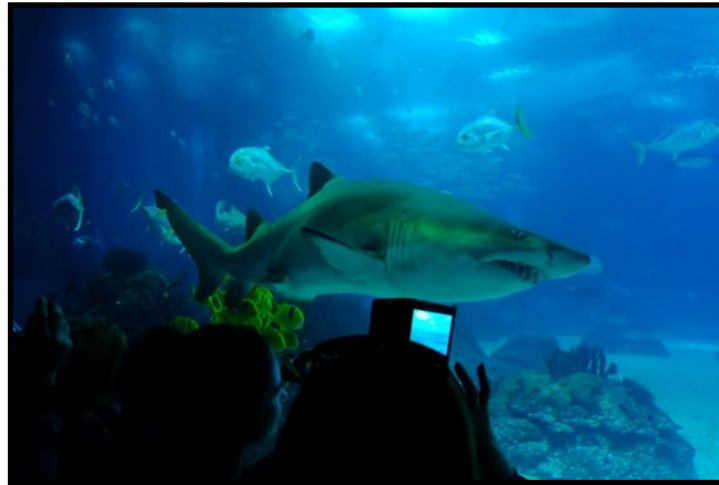

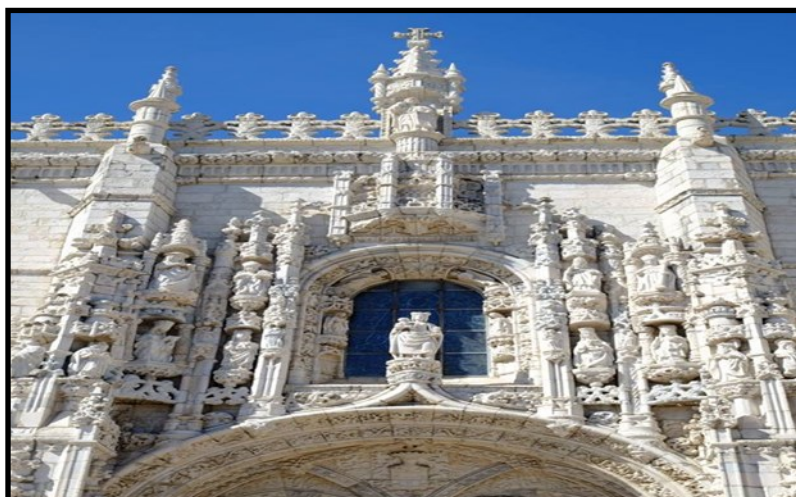
In the afternoon we have showed our power point presentations about school annual events.

This grand religious building was historically associated with the early sailors and explorers. It was from here that Vasco da Gama spent his last night before his voyage to the Far East.



The “ Belém tower”, is the symbol of the city and it represents a fortified tower which defends the river Tago. It was amazing , because we saw a very old tower built in 1521.



On Wednesday we went again to their school. The students explained us some Physic and Chemistry experiments, and in the Afternoon a student explained us Mathematic tricks.





On Thursday we went to Leiria region. We visited a lot of important things like the Sanctuary of Fatima, or the medieval town of Obidos and the Batalha Monastery.
