## **CASTELBUONO MEETING**

## 23rd - 29th OCTOBER 2016

On 23rd October there was, at F. Minà Palumbo School in Castelbuono, an international meeting of our Erasmus+ Project: Creative European School C.L.I.C.K. Six countries have taken part to this event: Lithuania, Spain, Greece, Portugal, Romania and Italy.
